In VCE:

- Our highest achievers (10% of all students) received an ATAR rank above 90
- 23% of all students achieved an ATAR rank of 80 and above
- 82% of students applied for a tertiary place
- 88% of these students received a University offer
- 9% of these students received a TAFE offer
- 3% of students received an offer from an Independent Training College


