Important information around scored assessments:

There are a variety of qualifications available in VCE / VET Programs. Some of these provide credit towards VCE Units 1 and 2, others can provide credit towards VCE Units 1 – 4.*

1. Students undertaking VCE VET Unit 3/4 sequences with a scored assessment will be able to withdraw from one school based VCE study once course entry is confirmed.

- A **request for withdrawal of VCE study form** will be available from the Senior School Office in February 2020 for students who are undertaking an external VCE VET Unit 3/4 study.
- Students will then have **one week to complete and submit** the application form for processing after which time no withdrawal from a VCE study will be permitted
- In 2020, the following VCE / VET Programs will have a Unit 3/4 scored assessment (study score) and students will be able to withdraw from one VCE study.

- Will continue to undertake their full quota of studies in their school based VCE Program - (Five subjects at year 12 level).

Students applying for an external VET Program:

- Both you and your parent/guardian will receive notification of your application details.
- All outstanding materials from 2019 must be paid prior to application.
- All VET studies will incur fees for materials. These fees are set by the provider and in 2019 fees ranged from \$130 to \$840* depending on the course. Host schools may require students to purchase text books. This will be an additional cost.

* Equine studies incur significantly higher costs.
- If the materials fee is not paid to Eltham High School by **February 2020** your VET Application may be withdrawn. This will mean you would need to resume your fully allocated VCE Course at school. (If you are experiencing financial hardship, payment arrangements can be made by contacting our Acting Business Manager, Lauren Keenan, on 9430 5101).
- VET classes begin Week 2 in 2020.
- VET classes and enrolments are finalised Week 4 of Term 1 in 2020.
- Any withdrawals must be made in writing to the VET/VCAL Coordinator, who will then withdraw students from the course.

SWL Structured Work Placement may be a requirement or a recommendation for the VET Program.

These placements must follow Host requirements. Students and families are required to source their own placements. The Victorian State Government provides arrangement forms and guidelines. Please contact Terri Wood (VET/VCAL Coordinator) for advice as needed.

SWR Structured Work Place Recognition is available to students completing 80 plus hours of work placement. This may provide credits towards the completion of the VCE.

Eltham High School strongly recommends that students plan their SWL placement during school holidays (excluding the Christmas break).
