Dear Parents/Guardians,

Welcome to Eltham High School. The Music Program at Eltham High School is nationally renowned for its excellence and is recognised as one of the finest Instrumental Music Programs in Australia. We pride ourselves on having an outstanding team of instrumental music staff who will ensure that your children develop the skills required to enjoy creating music on their instrument. Eltham High School's Instrumental Program caters for all woodwind, brass, percussion and string instruments.

During Orientation Day on December 7, all of the new Year 7 students will attend a music information session that will involve performances by our Music Staff and Students. As part of this performance the various instruments that we offer in the music program will be demonstrated and the students will listen to a selection of ensembles.

As part of our instrument selection process in 2022, students will be able to try various instruments that we offer as part of our Instrumental Music Program. This will involve a short lesson with our instrumental staff that will allow the students to experiment with making their first sounds on each instrument. Our staff will ensure that all instruments are cleaned, sanitized and follow all the appropriate Covid Safe protocols.

Year 7 Instrumental Music Night – Wednesday, 9 February 2022

The night will start at 6:30pm and run at Eltham High School or online, as required at the time of the event. An outline of the Music Program will be presented, including information on purchasing instruments, fees and lesson structure. Staff will also be available to answer any questions you might have about your child's involvement in our Instrumental Music Program.

Timbre Test

During the first week of Term 1 2022 students who have completed an Expression of Interest Form will be invited to sit a timbre test which objectively provides an indication of instruments that may best suit your child. Studies show that students who play instruments that match their timbre preference perform better and have a greater continuation rate than students who play instruments not matched to their timbre preference.

The Instrumental Music Program is self-funded and the following fees applied in 2021. There will be a slight increase in fees for 2022, which you will be provided with at the Instrumental Music Night. Payment is made over a four part payment plan for Training Band and Training Strings students.

Weekly lesson and rehearsal (minimum of 30 lessons per year)	\$950
Ensemble Fee (including costs of excursions and music camp)	\$420
Percussion levy (if applicable)	\$350
Instrument hire (if applicable)	\$600
